The wolf eel (*Anarrhichthys ocellatus*) is a species of wolffish (*Anarrhichthidae*) from the north Pacific. It is monotypic within the genus *Anarrhichthys* and one of only two genera in the family, the other being *Anarrhichas*. Elephants, whales, okapi, hippopotamuses, and rhinoceroses communicate in frequencies lower than what humans can hear, less than 20 Hz. At these frequencies, called infrasonic, humans can only feel vibrations. Neural crest cells, somites, gills with cartilaginous or bone supports (absent in *Mylokunnmingia*?), tripartite brain and paired cranial sense organs, cranium with anterior notochord, semi-circular canal(s), 1 heart, kidneys.
